

Major Scale



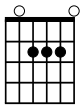

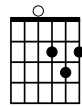

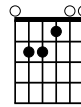
